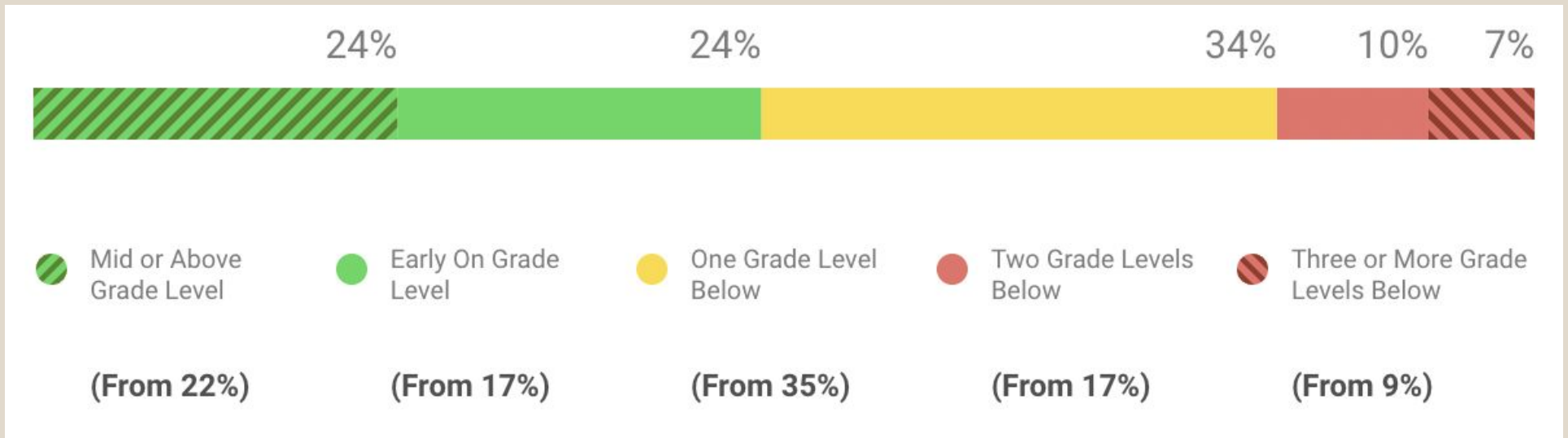

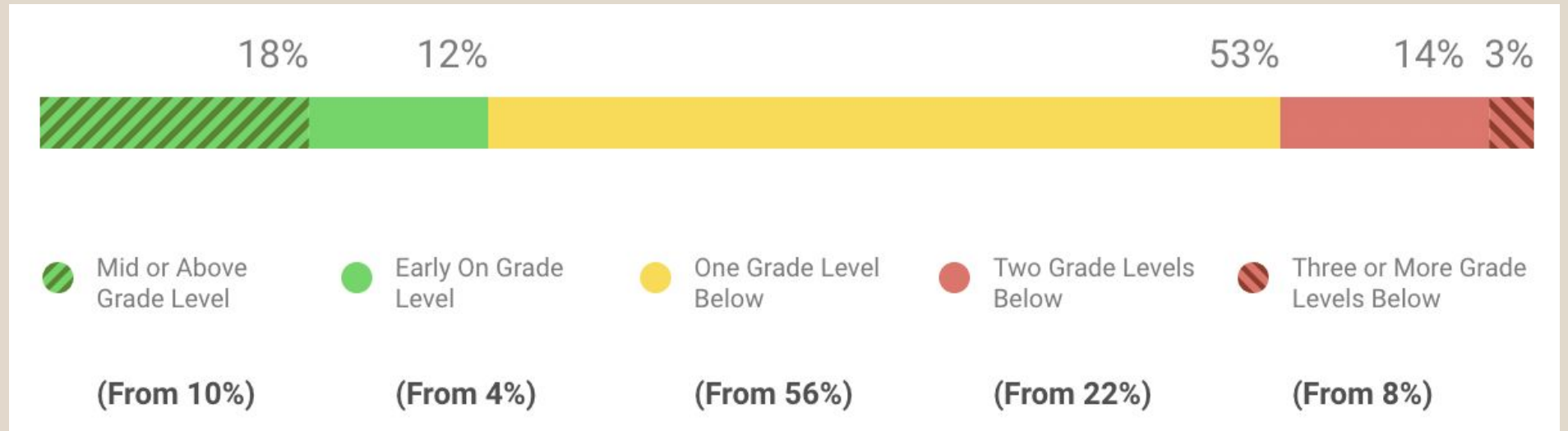
Reading - September - November 2022
