## Required Observances (Veterans Day, Constitution Day, Temperance and Good Citizenship Day, Disability History Month)

Principals will be responsible for the preparation and presentation of educational activities in observance of Veteran's Day.

Constitution Day will be observed each year on September 17 in commemoration of the September 17, 1787, signing of the United States Constitution.

Temperance and Good Citizenship Day will be observed on January 16 or, if on a non-school day, the Friday preceding January 16.

Disability History Month will be observed during the month of October that provide instruction, awareness and understanding of disability history and people with disabilities.
